

The Tohokudai-ID Confirmation Website

The user authentication (ID) to be issued to all Tohoku University students is shown below. Access the Tohokudai-ID Confirmation website **after March 31** to check each ID and initial password. Make a note or print it out and keep it in a safe place so that you will not forget it. **After 8:30 AM (JST) on April 1**, set up your student email (DCMail) using your Tohokudai-ID.

Tohokudai-ID	The Tohokudai-ID is a standard ID for various information services. Some services use Student-ID in place of Tohokudai-ID.
Sub-ID(Campus Wi-Fi ID)	The user ID for the Wi-Fi service is as follows: [Sub-ID]@student.tohoku.ac.jp
Google Workspace ID	This ID is for the Google Workspace services such as Gmail, Drive, Meet, and Classroom. This Gmail service is called DCMail or Email service for Students.
Microsoft365 ID	This ID is for Microsoft365 services such as Office365, OneDrive, and Teams.

How to learn your temporary ID and the password

Confirmation period : from March 31 ~ to April 30

- The temporary ID and password to access the Tohokudai ID confirmation website are as follows.

<i>Temporary ID</i>	your examinee' s number
<i>Password</i>	For undergraduate students, it is the "password for the admission procedure website" on the acceptance letter. For graduate students, it is the "Tohokudai-ID Confirmation Password" on the acceptance letter or the enclosed document.

Acceptance letter or enclosed materials
Temporary ID (your examinee's number) : * * * *
PW for the admission procedure website (confirming your Tohokudai-ID) : ●●●●

The above temporary ID and password can use until October 31.

Setting period : After 8:30 AM (JST), April 1

1. Visit the "Online Guide of Information Services in Tohoku University" and refer to the "SRP Student Portal" (Secure Reverse Proxy) service. After that, log in to SRP.
